## ABOUT FIRST & FIRST ROBOTICS COMPETITION

FIRST® is a robotics community that prepares young people for the future. The world's leading youth-serving nonprofit advancing STEM education outcomes, FIRST designs mentor-guided research and robotics programs for kids from pre-kindergarten through high school. Boosted by a global support system of mentors, coaches, volunteers, alumni, and sponsors, teams conduct research, fundraise, design, and build robots of their creation. For over 30 years, students from all walks of life have developed self-confidence in STEM, meaningful friendships, and valuable, real-world skills through FIRST that open pathways and help young people build a better future.

FIRST is a progression of programs:

- **FIRST LEGO League Discover** (Grades PreK-1)
- **FIRST LEGO League Explore** (Grades 2-4)
- **FIRST LEGO League Challenge** (Grades 4-8)
- **FIRST Tech Challenge** (Grades 7-12)
- **FIRST Robotics Competition** (Grades 9-12)



**FIRST Robotics Competition** teams compete with industrial-size robots of their own design, combining the excitement of sport with the rigors of science and technology.

**Students, Ages 14-18 (Grades 9-12), get to:**

- Work alongside professional engineers
- Build and compete with a robot
- Learn to use sophisticated hardware and software
- Develop design, project management, programming, teamwork, strategic thinking, and *Coopertition* skills
- Earn a place in the FIRST Championship
- Access exclusive scholarships from hundreds of colleges and universities

## GAME OVERVIEW: REBUILT

In REBUILT<sup>SM</sup> presented by Haas, two competing alliances are invited to score fuel, cross obstacles, and climb the tower before time runs out. Alliances earn additional rewards for meeting specific scoring thresholds.

### 0:20 Autonomous Period:

Robots follow pre-programmed instructions to score points by:

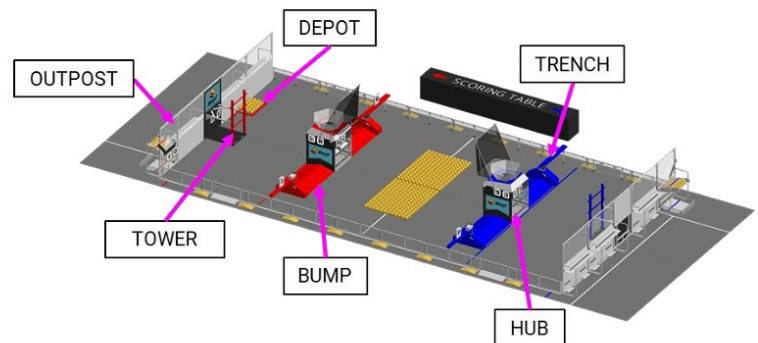
- Leaving their starting zone,
- Climbing the tower on their alliance side
- Collecting & scoring fuel into the hub

### 2:20 Driver-Controlled:

Drivers take control of robots & Alliances score points by:

- Retrieving & scoring fuel in their hub
- Climbing the tower
- Human players scoring fuel into the alliance hub

The Alliance with that earns the most points wins the match!
